Peter Jackson Design tackled this brief by setting the building atop an appropriate undulation and providing an open-style layout that affords view planes to all the desired features mentioned.

The home features traditional conservatory glazing to let in the warming sun. Natural materials used include natural stonework (both inside and out), exposed recycled rough sawn timbers, and corrugated iron – integrating the home and environment perfectly. Cathedral style ceilings and numerous gables create the English influence sentiment.

As per the client's brief, Peter Jackson Design ensured the home is environmentally sustainable. Recycled timber doors and windows have been used to construct the residence. All rainwater is harvested and stored in tanks while all sewerage is treated and recycled appropriately. The concrete floor structure and mass stonework act as heat banks, deriving their heat source directly from the sun through strategically positioned glazing and fireplaces.

Peter Jackson Design has proven once again they can create stunning, liveable homes, no matter what the brief.
